## The courses offered at INPENS are:

- Beautician and Aesthetic
- Electrical
- Mechanical Engineering Draughtsman
- Computer System
- Women Dress Maker
- Air Conditioning and Refrigeration
- Vehicle Mechanic Motor (Automotive)
- Industrial Electronic (Equipment)
- Hair Dressing

In line with the aim to strengthen the skilled workforce set in the state, many establishments are set up to train and teach school-leavers in various general fields. This not only multiplies the pool of skilled workers in the state, it acts as an enticement for investors, spurring them to set up in Selangor.

Established in 1993, Industri Pendidikan Negeri Selangor (INPENS) is wholly owned by the Selangor State Government. The new INPENS campus is situated in Jalan Semarak, Kuala Selangor. Opening its doors in June 2008, it is located approximately 45 kilometres from Shah Alam or Klang and about an hour drive from the Kuala Lumpur city centre. The campus, which sits on a 16acre site comprises five building blocks. This campus can accommodate approximately 1,000 students in all.

### For the Skilled Set

INPENS currently offers nine courses with Skilled Programmes for school-leavers those 17 years and above. The college also provides industrial training to final year students with the objective of helping them gaining career exposures.

Skill Development Department under the Human Resource Ministry has approved all the INPENS certificated programmes. To date the college has produced approximately 4,800 graduates.

### Operation Ground

The college currently operates with a total of 31 classrooms, 20 tutorial rooms and an auditorium, all of which are well equipped with complete audio-visual aids and an LCD projectors for better learning and demonstration. Others facilities include a library, eight computer

laboratories, including information multimedia, AutoCAD retrieval and networking labs which are equipped with the latest software applications.

Because many of the courses at this college involve practical work, the college has prepared appropriate facilities for its students. The college now has four fully equipped automotive workshop, two air-conditioning workshops, four electrical workshops and two electronics workshops.
